

DECLARATION OF RESULT

DUSTON NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING REFERENDUM

5TH NOVEMBER 2015

I, the undersigned, being the Deputy Counting Officer at the Neighbourhood Planning Referendum for the Duston area held on the 5th day of November 2015, do hereby give notice that the number of votes recorded at the said Referendum is as follows:

QUESTION IN REFERENDUM	
Do you want Northampton Borough Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Duston Parish to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?	
Number of votes cast in favour of a 'YES'	1796
Number of votes cast in favour of a 'NO'	302

The number of ballot papers rejected was as follows:	
a) want of official mark	0
b) voting for more than one answer	0
c) writing or mark by which the voter/proxy could be indentified	6
d) unmarked or void for uncertainty	2
Total	8

The total number of votes recorded represented 16.6 % of the registered electors (eligible electorate 12719)
