How we can help

If you are self-isolating and have no other forms of support, you can contact Northamptonshire County Council to request help with:

- Urgent food deliveries
- Prescription medication collection (delivered by our staff or district/ borough council employees)
- · General support with loneliness
- · Help to get online
- Posting mail



How does it work?

When we receive your request we will pass your details to your local borough or district council who will match you with local volunteers or voluntary organisations.

They will respond to you directly within 48 hours of you contacting us. to discuss your needs and make plans to support you.

Please be aware that we will prioritise people in urgent need of food.
