## CSC28/24. Free2Talk Report

- Cllrs Maitland & Roper with the Clerk held an online meeting with Free2Talk.
- RESOLVED:

  - b) The current Service Level Agreement should be readopted for another 12 months from November 2024 to November 2025

#### CSC29/24. Seed Funding

- RESOLVED:
  - a) To look for examples of other parish councils that do seed funding and see what processes they use.
  - b) The Clerk to draw up an application form for the Committee to consider proposing to Full Council.

#### CSC30/24. Promoting Peace

Cllr Maitland described the purpose of the white poppy. It is a flower used as a symbol
of peace and is worn place of the red poppy. The white poppy stands for remembrance

- for all victims of war, a commitment to peace, and a challenge to attempts to glorify war.
- Traditionally remembrance has focused on the military and soldiers fighting each other in battles. A view was expressed that in 2025 the Parish Council should focus on the promotion of peace instead.
- It was suggested that a working party could be set up to try and progress peace celebrations in Duston rather than the traditional military remembrance.
- RESOLVED: Councillors to come up with ideas of how to promote peace activities in Duston. These ideas will be discussed at a future meeting of the Community Services Committee.

### CSC31/24. Defibrillator in the old Village Centre

- There is a defibrillator at St Lukes Centre.
- It was suggested in the phone box but it is still not clear when BT will decommission this.
- **RESOLVED:** To the Clerk to find out if a defibrillator on a wall needs planning permission due to it being a in conservation area.
